If you live, work or have some other interest in the geographical area in which the Association works or otherwise interested in the activities of the Association or organisations who hold a share in the Association and whose names are entered in the Register of Members

Thenue Housing

- owns and/or manages about 3500 properties in and around Glasgow
- builds new homes and improves older ones
- provides services to other housing organisations and groups

Who can become a member?

- Thenue tenants
- Service users of the Association
- other persons who support the objects of the Association
- Organisations sympathetic to the objects of the Association

Members can ...

- Attend the annual general meeting and any other general meeting of the association
- Elect the Board of Management
- Stand for election to the Board of Management
- Appoint auditors
- Receive, upon request, copies of any of the association's policies and procedures or other appropriate information

But membership does not

- help anyone qualify for a house
- give anyone priority for repairs or other services

How to join

- complete the application form and send it to our office
- meet with the Chief Executive to discuss your membership application and pay £1
- wait for confirmation that the Board of Management has approved your application, then you will be sent a share certificate and a copy of the rule book

The Board of Management

- the Board is elected by the members
- it makes the major strategic and policy decisions
- there are 15 places on the Board

However

- Board members do not get personal benefits
- They are not paid and cannot be employed by Thenue
- They do not deal with or find out about other tenants' personal business
